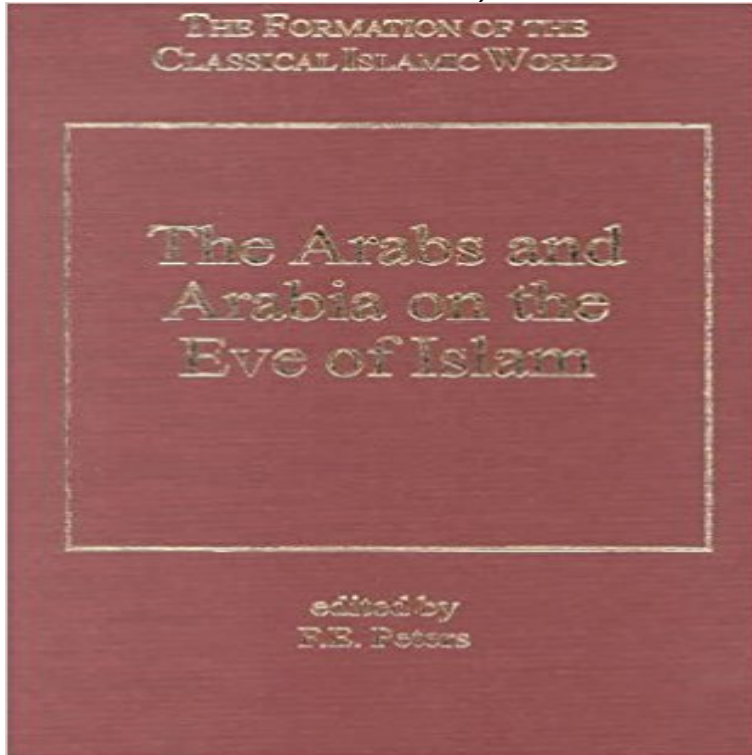


The Arabs and Arabia on the Eve of Islam (The Formation of the Classical Islamic World)

The following papers set out the political and economic structures of the pre-Islamic period, and are concerned to trace the evolution of religious beliefs in the area, looking in particular at the role of local traditions and the impact of Jewish and Christian influences.
