
Waiting Was Not An Option: A true chronicle of a 46 year-old man diagnosed with Gleason 7 prostate cancer.

My story ends well, as I have been cancer free for over 3 years and counting, and I have since regained my normal family and professional life without any impact on the quality of my life. What I truly want to present here in this book is one mans version of dealing with this disease, and to show what happened to me, from one mans own perspective and interpretation. Not from a doctor, not from a nurse, not even from another prostate cancer patient. Just from one, diagnosed man. This book is my journal of my experiences with my prostate cancer.
