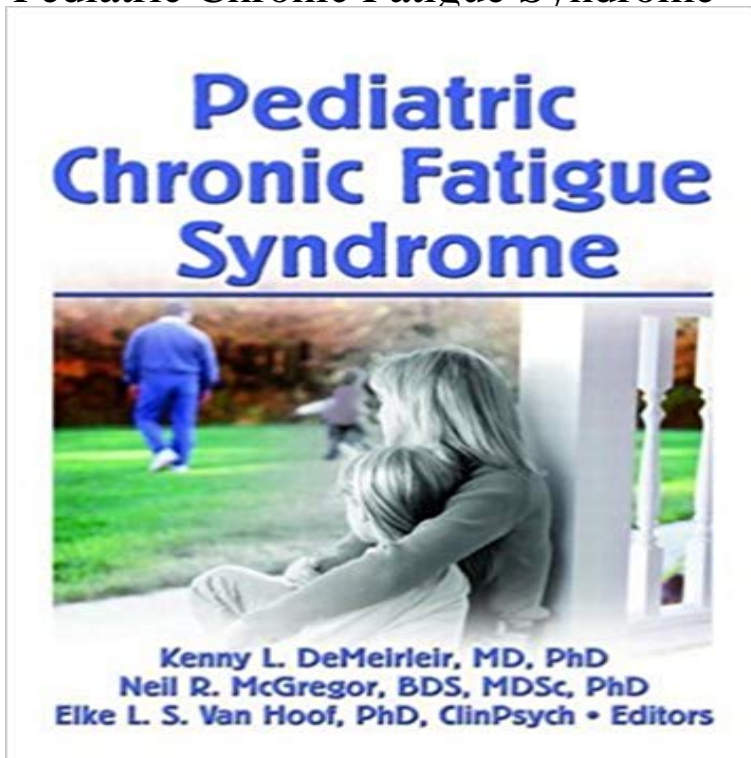


Pediatric Chronic Fatigue Syndrome
